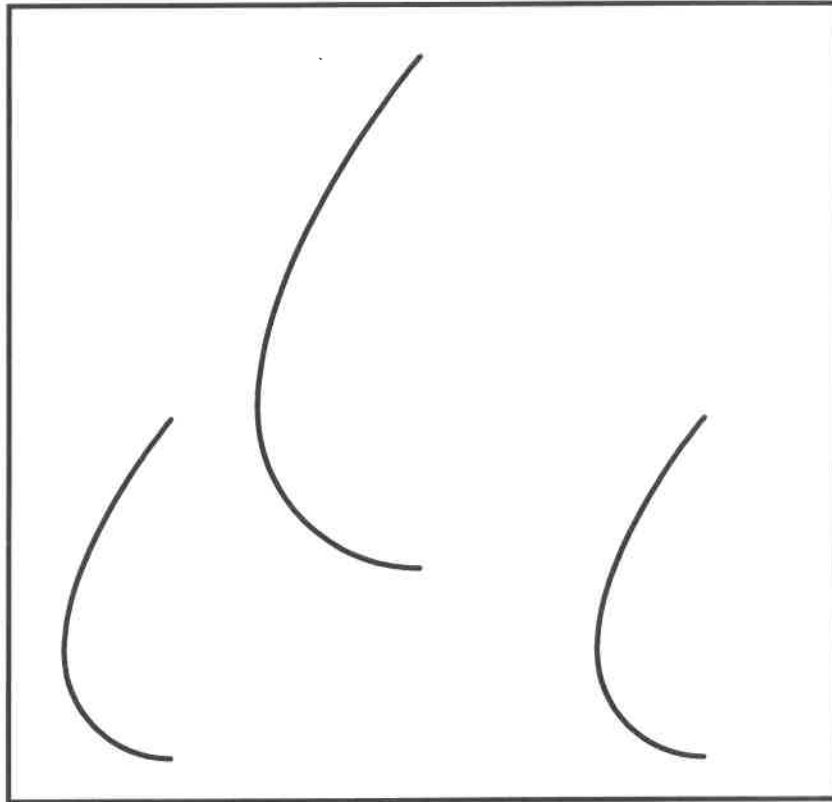


# FINISH the DRAWING

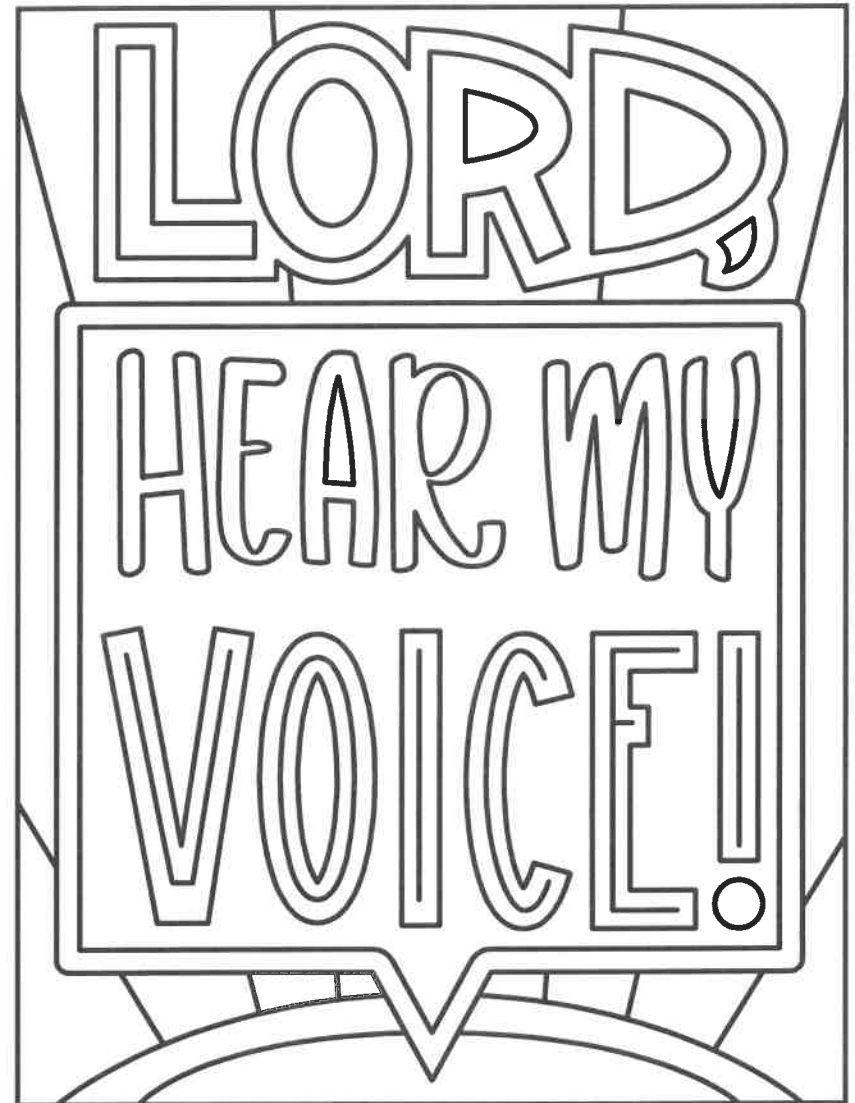

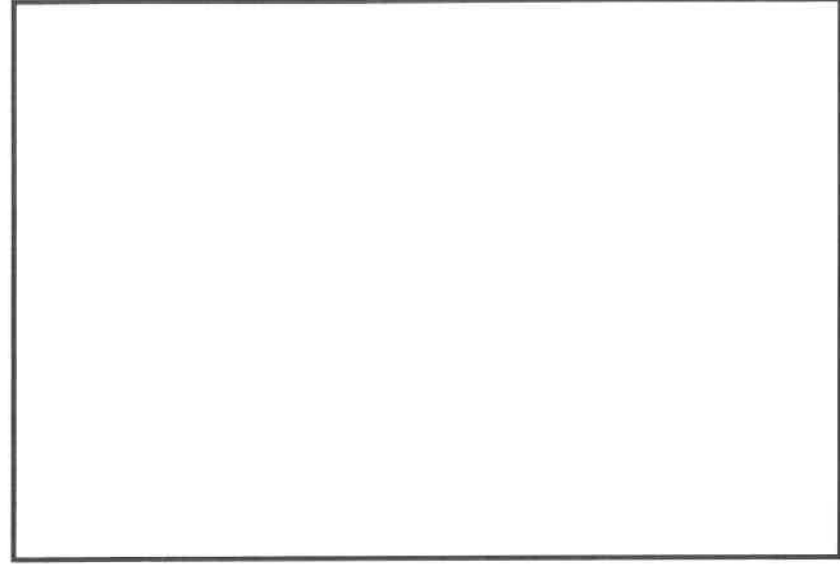
